Practical protection for connection



Increase network and Wifi security

- Change default passwords
- Change the network name (aka SSID)
- Set up a guest network
- Reduce signal strength to your home
- Upgrade the firmware
- Disable remote management

Increase data security

- Store backup data using external media or a cloud based service
- Purchase endpoint protection

Increase general and IoT device security

- Review out of box device permissions and disable/remove unwanted functions
- Configure automatic software updates
- Get rid of old technology
