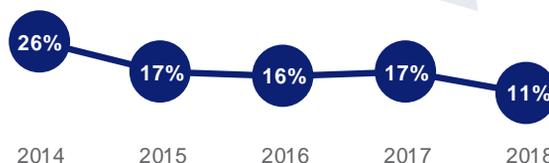


## Economic uncertainty no longer ranks as the top concern in the survey, breaking a five-year trend.

Instead, competition from big businesses is the biggest concern.

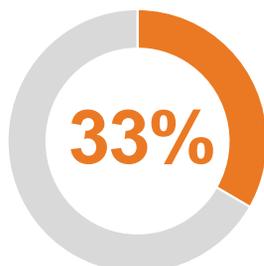
## Small business owners aren't stressed about tax reform.

At the time of the survey, 37 percent expected a positive impact from tax reform compared to just 19 percent who expected a negative impact.



## One third of business owners have exit plans.

Most are looking to eventually transfer to family members or dissolve their business. A majority also feel confident about a successful transition within the next 10 years.

## Ethical issues are overall uncommon.

However, business owners value ethical behavior and enforce it themselves.



**Only 10% of small businesses have faced an ethical issue in the past year**

**93%** Believe ethical behavior is important when in hiring

**68%** Business owners promote / enforce ethical behavior themselves



## Small business owners want their bank to provide omni-channel flexibility.

Despite a decline in branch-banking, face-to-face contact still plays a large role for problem resolution.

Increased desire for technology in banking has brought rise to new “contactless” debit/credit methods



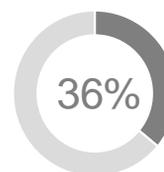
